

/Newton and Noss Parish Council – Snow Plan

Introduction

The Parish Council has acquired a gritter and has access to limited supplies of salt. These resources are under the direction of a Snow Warden. Currently the Snow Warden is Mr Paul Clark. Mr Clark may ask volunteers to help him from time to time.

Snow Plan

- The County Council has responsibility for keeping primary routes clear. Currently these are limited to the B3186 as far as the Co-op and the road from Fiveways to Bridgend. In practice County has been doing more than this and it also has secondary route commitments.
- In extreme snow or ice conditions the Snow Warden will use the Parish resources to try to maintain access from Bridgend to the Village Hall in Noss via St Peters and also via The Swan. In Newton Ferrers the routes covered will be from the Co-op to the bus turning bay at the end of Yealm Road and from Holy Cross up Court Road to the start of Lower Court Road.
- We must emphasise that no commitment can be made to keeping any route open. Everything will depend on resources and the extremity of the weather. The conditions in which the Snow Plan will operate are entirely at the discretion of the Snow Warden.
- The Snow Plan will only operate in extreme conditions and parishioners must continue to take all the usual precautions in icy and/or snowy conditions.
